In over fifteen years of offering help and hope to young mothers and supporting them in choosing life for the unborn children, I have had the blessing of playing a "grandmother" role to many children, sometimes even being present in the delivery room and being listed on the hospital website. What a joy to watch these children grow and flourish as their parents use the education and support they received at Heart Choices to establish safe and loving home environments.

The need continues to be great, however. Our center is here to gently guide these women and families to the choice of life and provide the resources they need to be a godly, responsible parent. Heart Choices has been filling the needs of those in crisis since 2002 and has been able to provide classes, supplies, and emotional support to those in our community when they need it most.

As we quickly approach the end of another year of ministry, I am rejoicing at the many blessings we have seen in 2017! This year we were honored to serve **173** clients in **1028** visits at our locations in Beloit, Concordia, Osborne, and Smith Center! That's over 300 more visits than last year. **25** women received services on the mobile ultrasound unit which we sponsor in Concordia each month, helping them choose life for their babies, and we filled over **350** material aid requests.

God has also blessed us with partners like you who come alongside us with prayer, time, and support. To those individuals, we say THANK YOU!! They have given of themselves because of their heart for the needy in our community and their response to God's command to feed the hungry, clothe the naked, and value human life. Without the blessing of these supporters, the work could not be done and lives would be lost.

HANNAH REARDON EARNS BREASTFEEDING ACCREDITATION

Hannah Reardon, a volunteer client advocate for Heart Choices, recently became accredited as a Breastfeeding Counselor through Breastfeeding USA. Breastfeeding USA is an organization that empowers breastfeeding moms through mother-to-mother support.

Hannah has been providing informal breastfeeding support to Heart Choices clients since 2011, but states: "Earlier this year I had several friends who faced exceptionally difficult breastfeeding challenges. I recognized my need for additional training and made the commitment to become a Breastfeeding Counselor. I was able to successfully complete all my coursework online. I am a stay-at-

home and homeschool mom to 3 little ones yet I can still be a resource to new moms by offering free breastfeeding support through texts, phone calls and Facebook. I look forward to adding to the network of breastfeeding education and support already available in North Central Kansas."

Hannah hosts a monthly breastfeeding Lunch & Learn event at Heart Choices on the 3rd Tuesday of each month at noon. The December 19th meeting will focus on "Cookies and FAQs." All breastfeeding moms (and babies) and moms-to-be are welcome to attend. There will be additional Facebook classes offered online for moms who are unable to attend meetings in person. The Facebook Group can be found by searching for "NCK Breastfeeding Lunch and Learn."

Heart Choices also offers a "Simply Breastfeeding" module as a part of the "Earn While You Learn" program. This module is offered free of charge at all locations and is open to any mothers who wish to learn about the benefits and techniques of breastfeeding.
